#### Product overview

Cisco® multi-head cables provide flexibility and pleasing aesthetics in meeting rooms, and hassle-free content sharing for the user. The cables can connect a wide range of laptops to a Cisco video-conferencing systems without the hassle of using multiple dongles. #### Features and benefits

- The multi-head cable 4K is compatible with all devices in the Cisco Webex® Room Series and Board Series and delivers up to 4K content resolution.
- The multi-head cable 1080p is compatible with the Cisco SX and MX series and recommended for devices that are limited to 1080p content.
